



Summer Reading Program Begins in June

It's almost time for the summer reading season and the Perry County Public Library will begin the summer reading program on Monday, June 4, 2018. The summer reading program is for children from birth through twelfth grade at both the Tell City and Cannelton locations. Several reading categories are specially designed to fit each reading level:

- ❖ Babies and Toddlers – birth through two years
- ❖ Preschool/Kindergarten – three through six years
- ❖ Children's – grades 1, 2 and 3
- ❖ Tweens – grades 4, 5 and 6
- ❖ Teens – grades 7 through 12

You do not have to register to participate in the summer reading program, just stop by the library (Tell City or Cannelton location) beginning Monday, June 4 and pick up the appropriate reading form, read your favorite books, and return the completed form to the library for a prize. Then do it all over again! The reading program will conclude at the end of the day on Thursday, July 19.

To receive a prize, just read the following number of books:

- ❖ Babies and Toddlers – 10 easy reader books or board books
- ❖ Preschool/Kindergarten – 10 easy reader books
- ❖ Children's (grades 1, 2 and 3) – 10 easy reader books or 2 chapter books
- ❖ Tweens (grades 4, 5 and 6) – 2 chapter books or 4 graphic novels
- ❖ Teens (grades 7 through 12) – 2 chapter books or 4 graphic novels

On Friday, July 20 at 1:00 p.m. anyone involved in summer reading or the activities will be invited to an open house to see the new technology in the children's department, and to make ice cream sundaes.

Wednesday afternoons at Cannelton: 1:00-2:00	Preschool/Kindergarten/Elementary ages 3 – grade 3
Thursday mornings at Tell City: 9:30-10:30	Preschool/Kindergarten ages 3 - 6
Thursday afternoons at Tell City: 1:00-2:00	Preschool/Kindergarten ages 3 - 6

Registration is required to attend the weekly activities. Please choose one day and one time for the appropriate age/grade of your child (the grade that they have been promoted to) and that will be the day and time that you attend each week.
